Mission Statement

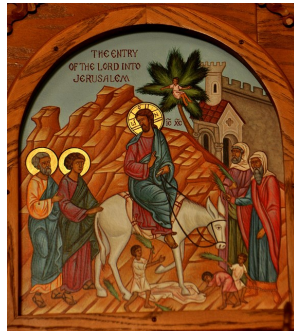
