Our Service Program is an important component of bringing to life our SPCS Mission:

- ***Service*** provides hands-on, interactive, experiential education about life, ***faith*** & those in need (*i.e. poor/sick/orphaned/outcast*).
- Service ***inspires*** students to have a greater appreciation for the basic necessities of life we often take for granted, such as food, clothing, shelter, education, faith etc.
- Service invites students to ***develop their God given gifts and talents*** by responding to Christ's call to live with a preferential love for those in need.
- Service helps our students to have a grounded view of the world in order to help them discern and ***fulfill the plan God has for their lives***.

“For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me.’ Then the righteous will say answer him and say, ‘Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? When did we see you a stranger and welcome you, or naked and clothe you? When did we see you ill or in prison, and visit you?’ And the king will say in reply, ‘Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me.’”

- As Catholic Christians we take seriously the commandment of service to others and believe in the words of Jesus when he said: “Whatever you do for the least of my people, you do it for me.” (Mt 25:40)
- This command to put our faith into practice is a foundational reason for the existence of our service program here at St. Paul’s Catholic School.
