No child will be dismissed to the festival without their parent's written permission.

Please review festival safety rules with your child/children. Make sure they know where the Information Booth is in the event they need assistance. Also, make them aware that security personnel will be wearing orange colored shirts should the children need security assistance. Remember, for safety reasons, children are not allowed to be in the food booths.
